In contrast with thrombin, which converts fibrinogen into fibrin by splitting off fibrinopeptides A and B, the thrombin-like enzyme only splits off fibrin peptide A. They have been extensively studied both by basic researchers and clinicians because of potential therapeutic use in myocardial infarction and thrombotic diseases




